The South African Bureau of Standards (SABS) is the apex national standardisation institution in South Africa, established by the Standards Act, 1945 (Act No. 24 of 1945). SABS continues to exist under the Standards Act, 2008 (Act No. 8 of 2008) with the following mandate:

- Develop, promote and maintain South African National Standards (SANS);
- Promote quality in connection with commodities, products and services; and
- Render conformity assessment services and matters connected therewith.



SABS is a Schedule 3B public entity under the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999) (PFMA). SABS provides conformity assessment services such as, Laboratory Services (testing), Certification (system and product), Training and Consulting, Consignment Inspection, Local Content Verification and Design support for SMMEs and entrepreneurs.

System Certification

Local Content Verification


SABS is appointed by the Department of Trade and Industry (the dti) to conduct local verification services in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA) regulation. The local content verification is aligned to designated products and according to SANS 1286.

Consignment Inspection

SABS offers independent Consignment Inspection services to provide assurance that the content of consignments meet the production and quality requirements of the procuring entity.

Certificate of Compliance

In partnership with the Independent Communications Authority of South Africa (ICASA), SABS issues Certificates of Compliance (CoCs) to provide safety and performance assurance of products and devices. This service is rendered for electromagnetic interference and electromagnetic compatibility (EMI/EMC) products, to ensure that only products that have been certified as safe and reliable will be allowed into the South African market.
